	3) Seek opportunities to gain leadership experience. Take on more responsibility in my unit, my community (MyMilitary GPS LeadershipPlan>Leadership in Action>Community Involvement) or my college (MyMilitary GPS LeadershipPlan>Leadership in Action>Campus Involvement .)	Within next 2-3 weeks
	4) Begin communicating with a Veterans Employment Representative at MyMilitary GPS CareerPlan >Link on Online Career Resources .	Within the next 3 weeks
	5) Create a resume, cover letter, and eFolio using the resources at MyMilitary GPS CareerPlan >Marketing Yourself and Finding a Job .	Within 1-2 months
	6) Communicate with people in my career network about my job search. Ideas on networking at MyMilitary GPS CareerPlan> Marketing Yourself and Finding a Job> Career Networking	Within 1-2 months
	7) Set up 2 interviews for an entry-level health care job. Prepare for them by using resources at MyMilitary GPS CareerPlan >Marketing Yourself and Finding a Job>Interviewing Essentials . Write responses to at least 5 frequently asked interview questions.	Within 2-3 months
